What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the OneAnswer KiwiSaver Scheme Balanced Growth Fund. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you to compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The Balanced Growth Fund invests mainly in share and listed property assets, with some exposure to cash and fixed interest assets. It may also invest in alternative assets. The objectives of the Balanced Growth Fund are to:

- Consistently deliver stable real investment returns in the form of income and capital growth by investing in a range of asset-
- · Achieve investment performance that reflects the level of risk applicable to the Balanced Growth Fund's underlying asset classes.



How has the fund performed in the past?

What fees were members charged?

The returns above are after deductions for fund fees². These fees were last totalled up for the year end 31 March 2013 and were:

Members were also charged **membership fees**⁴ of up to \$24 over the year to 31 March 2014.


Example of how this applies to a member

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$920 (that's 9.20% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah also paid \$24 in membership fees. This gives Sarah a total return of \$896 for the year.

It is anticipated that other fees and costs will be lower because fund expenses have fallen as a percentage of the fund's value in the twelve months ended 31 March 2014.
