What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the OneAnswer KiwiSaver Scheme International Share Fund. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you to compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The International Share Fund invests in an underlying fund which invests in four actively managed portfolios of share assets listed on the sharemarket of any MSCI All Country World Index country (excluding Australia). It may also invest in cash assets. The objectives of the International Share Fund are to:

- Generate capital growth and competitive returns by investing directly or indirectly in securities issued by entities listed on stock exchanges around the world; and
- Outperform the MSCI All Countries (AC) World ex Australia Index with net dividends re-invested (New Zealand Dollar).

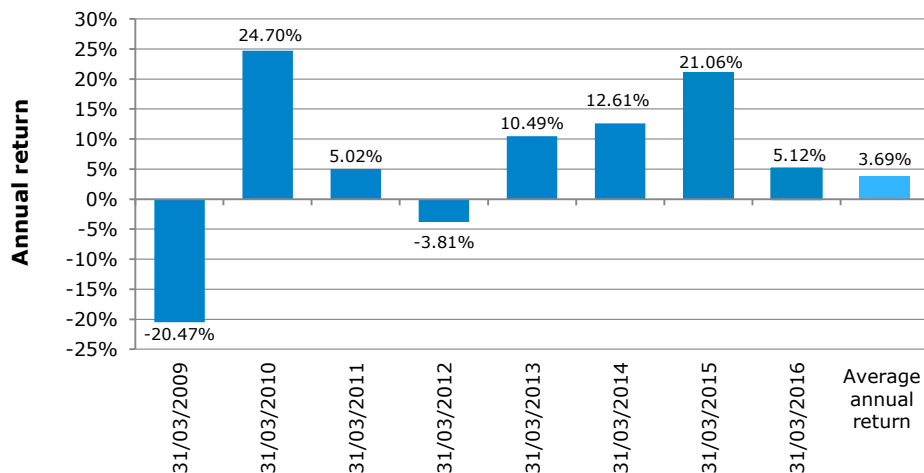

How has the fund performed?

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How has the fund performed in the past?

What fees were members charged?

Members were also charged **membership fees**³ of up to \$24 over the year to 31 March 2016.

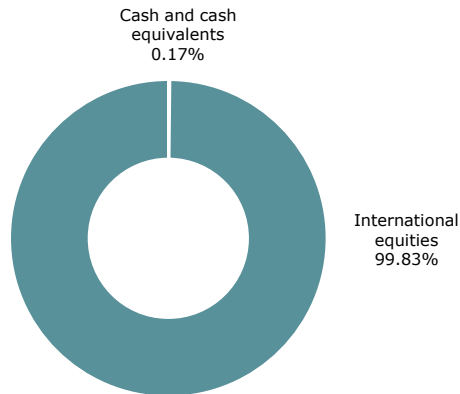
Example of how this applies to a member

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of -\$241 (that's -2.41% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah also paid \$24 in membership fees³. This gives Sarah a total return of -\$265 for the year.
