What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the OneAnswer KiwiSaver Scheme Sustainable Growth Fund. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you to compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The Sustainable Growth Fund invests mainly into a diversified portfolio of share assets and/or transferrable securities issued by companies pursuing a sustainable development policy and combining respect for social principles (such as human rights, non-discrimination and the issue of child labour) and environmental principles with good financial prospects. It may also invest in convertible securities and cash assets. The objective of the Sustainable Growth Fund is to outperform the MSCI World Index (New Zealand Dollar).



How has the fund performed in the past?

Members were also charged **membership fees**³ of up to \$24 over the year.


Example of how this applies to a member

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$1,920 (that's 19.20% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah also paid \$24 in membership fees³. This gives Sarah a total return of \$1,896 for the year.
